Corporate Personnel Circular – 1/2010

Subject:-AAI (Employees Medical Attendance and Treatment) Regulations, 2003 – Condition for dependency.

It has been decided to revise the existing condition of income limit of dependency for medical purposes from Rs.1500/- per month to Rs.3500/- per month. Accordingly, the para 3(1) of the AAI (Employees Medical Attendance and Treatment) Regulations, 2003 is amended as under:

“A member of the family whose total income from all sources, including pension (excluding D.A.), temporary increase on pension or stipend, etc does not exceed Rs.3500/- per month is deemed to be wholly dependent on the employee. However, husband and wife shall be considered as one unit for the purpose of claiming medical facilities.”

2. The employees are required to submit an undertaking to this effect, at the time of claiming medical benefits, and violation, if any, will attract disciplinary action in accordance with AAI Employees (CDA) Regulations. The above amendment may be incorporated in the claim form used for reimbursement of medical benefits.
3. The enhanced limit shall be effective from 1.12.2009.
4. This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
