**Subject:-Payment of 2nd Adjustable Adhoc Advance  
to Non-Executives against Wage Revision.**

Reference is made to this office letter of even number dated 29.9.2008 wherein adjustable ad-hoc advance was granted to the Non-Executives pending wage revision. It has been decided to further grant 2nd adjustable ad-hoc advance to all the non-executives as mentioned below:-

2. The above adjustable ad-hoc advance will be admissible to such Non-Executives who were on the rolls of the AAI as on 31.12.2006 and continue to be on the roll of the AAI on the date of issue of this circular.

3. **T**he adjustable ad-hoc advance as above will be payable with reference to the grade in which the Non-Executives was working as on 1.1.2007. However, employees who have been promoted after 1.1.2007 will be entitled to the advance in relation to the promoted higher grade on proportionate basis for the completed months.

4. **P**ro-rata payments will be made to the employees who have joined on or after 1.1.2007 calculated on pro-rata basis up to April, 2010. However, this does not imply that the monthly pro-rata ad-hoc amount will have any relationship with monthly increases which may accrue after the wage revision.

5. **I**n respect of employees separating from the AAI after receipt of the advance but before the implementation of wage revision, the entire advance paid to them will be recovered/ adjusted from their dues.

6. **T**he ad-hoc advance will not be admissible in the following cases:-

- (i) Those who are not on full time regular employment of AAI.
- (ii) Employees who are under suspension.
- (iii) Deputationists from other PSUs/ Government Department to AAI.

7. **T**he above ad-hoc advance will not count for any consequential payments.

8. **T**he ad-hoc advance will be adjusted against the wage revision arrears.

9. **I**ncome Tax as applicable will be recovered from the payment as above.

10. **T**he adjustable ad-hoc advance may be paid to eligible employees by 15th June, 2010.
